**\*Disclaimer:** Public health officials use WNV mosquito test results, combined with test results in birds, horses, and humans, to estimate WNV activity levels in Wyoming counties.

These data summarize voluntary reporting of WNV mosquito test results to Wyoming Department of Health by county mosquito control officials. Empty data cells may reflect a county's decision not to report test results or a lack of capability to test mosquitoes for presence of WNV.

During recent years, WDH has documented West Nile virus activity in every Wyoming county. Despite local mosquito trapping and testing efforts, WNV transmission may occur undetected. Negative test results or empty data cells in a given county do not necessarily indicate an absence of WNV.
